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CREATE THE LOOK

Award-winning bridal make-up artist **Ken Boylan**'s guide to creating the perfect bridal make-up look for autumn

As a make-up artist, I work on many brides throughout the year. When the client first visits me at my studio in Salon Zeba in Dublin, I ask if she has any pictures of make-up looks she likes. Most of the time, these pictures are of a well-known celebrity. Here, I have chosen three of the most requested celebrity looks for bridal make-up.

EVA LONGORIA

This is a classic make-up look for a wedding as it doesn't date. The foundation Eva has on has a slight dewiness, like **Armani Luminous Silk**, €45. If you are tanning, don't go too brown, especially in winter, and match your foundation to your tan.

Her eyes have lots of lashes, which can look really pretty. Individual lashes are the best for a wedding day as they don't mask the eyes. She has a beautiful shimmering silver/grey around her eyes, **Fuschia's Silver Eye Palette**, €28, would be great to use here. A cream blush has been used on the cheeks; something like **Brit Boy** from **MAC**, €21.50, would work well.

Cream blush looks fantastic and provides a nice glow, but remember a little gloss goes a long way! Use your finger to blend the blush on to your cheeks, give a little smile and place your blush on the apple of the cheek. I always recommend patting the blush on to the skin.

Her lips have a peach gloss effect. Try **Rimmel's Tiramissu Lip Liner**, €4.50, and **No2 Lip Gloss** from **Armani**, €24.50. Both have a peach tone, which looks great for a wedding.
